- ARTICLE 19. Shall the Town of Danville vote to raise, appropriate and expend the sum of \$28,000.00 to assist the Pope Memorial Library in meeting its operational expenses? YES  NO
- ARTICLE 20. Shall the Town of Danville vote to raise, appropriate and expend the sum of \$1,400.00 for services provided by Rural Community Transportation ("RCT") to residents who live in Danville? YES  NO
- ARTICLE 21. Shall the Town of Danville vote to raise, appropriate and expend the sum of \$1,200.00 to Umbrella, Inc., to serve victims of domestic and sexual violence and their children and families seeking child care and child care providers? YES  NO
- ARTICLE 22. Shall the Town of Danville vote to raise, appropriate and expend the sum of \$1,000.00 to assist the West Danville Community Club with operating expenses for Joe's Pond Beach? YES  NO

- ARTICLE 5. Shall the voters of the Danville School District authorize the Danville School Board to expend six million three hundred forty-six thousand ninety-one dollars (\$6,346,091.00) which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the 2021-2022 fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$17,611.00 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 1.2% lower than spending for the current year. YES  NO

Shall the voters of the Danville School District vote to authorize the Danville School Board to borrow money with which to pay its lawful debts and expenses for the fiscal year 2021-2022, in an amount not to exceed 90% of the anticipated collection of taxes and the receipt of other funds to be used for those purposes?
