Tires 18" or less = \$3.00/tire with no rim

Tires 18" or less = \$6.00/tire with rim

Tires 19" to 25" = \$9.00/tire with no rim

Tires 19" to 25" = \$18.00/tire with rim

Tires 25.5" and above = \$20.00/tire with no rim

Tires 25.5" and above = \$40.00/tire with rim

Our tire vendor has increased our per ton rate from \$130/ton to \$180/ton effective January 1, 2022. Towns and/or large generators of tires will be billed at the \$180/ton rate for any tires delivered after December 31, 2021.

According to the U.S. Tire Manufacturers Association, at least 20% of all passenger car tires sold in 2020 were on 17" and/or 18" rims. 225/65R17 was the most popular size at 4.5% of the market.

In addition, 79% of light truck tires were on 18" or less rims with LT275/70R18 being the top seller at 16.1%.

The NEKWMD has added a third price category to reflect the differences in tire sizes while keeping in mind what the most popular tire sizes are.
